Actor and Comedian Fred Stoller coming to Alexandria for East Coast Premiere screening of “Fred & Vinnie” presented by the 4th Alexandria Film Festival Saturday, November 6th at the AMC Hoffman Theatre at 7:15pm

“Fred and Vinnie,” a 90-minute comedy by Director Steve Skrovan (former stand-up comedian and writer for the CBS sitcom “Everybody Loves Raymond” and NBC’s “Seinfeld”) will make its East Coast Premiere at the Fourth Annual Alexandria Film Festival on Saturday, November 6th at 7:15PM.

Following the screening, actor and comedian Fred Stoller will host a Q & A session with the audience and share what went on behind the scenes during the making of the film about “Vinnie,” a happy agoraphobic who lives vicariously through “Fred,” his quirky friend.

Fred Stoller (“Fred”) has appeared on countless sitcoms, most notably as Ray’s mopey cousin on Everybody Loves Raymond, as Elaine’s forgetful date on Seinfeld, and as Monica’s bossy co-worker on Friends. In feature films, he was the annoying guy who gets punched through the phone booth in Dumb and Dumber, the moronic referee in Rebound, and a doting dad in Little Man. In animation, Fred could be heard as Steve the Tree on Nickelodeon’s Oswald, Stenographer Fred on ABC’s Science Court, as Rusty the monkey wrench on Disney’s Handy Manny, and as Chuck The Evil Sandwich Making Guy on PBS’s WordGirl. As a stand-up comedian, Fred appeared on HBO, The Tonight Show, and Late Night with David Letterman. Fred was a staff writer for Seinfeld and has also written for Handy Manny and National Lampoon magazine.

Angelo Tsarouchas (“Vinnie”) definitely exudes star power, his burly size and no holds barred attitude, have put him in high demand on the global comedy stage as well as in T.V. and film. Some of Angelo’s high-profile film credits include John Q, The Score, The Prince and Me and the critically acclaimed teen cult flick Harold and Kumar Go To Whitecastle. Angelo also appeared in the movie Cinderella Man starring Russell Crowe. He has also guest-starred on the hit show Mad Men.

Mr. Tsarouchas’ Showtime special has received critical acclaim and he has performed in festivals and venues all over the world, too many to mention! Fred and Vinnie is his first starring role.

The fourth annual Alexandria Film Festival—a tribute to cinematic art, featuring emerging and established filmmakers from all over the world will be held on Thursday, November 4 through Sunday, November 7, with a schedule of screenings to be presented at a series of locations in and around the City of Alexandria over the 4 day weekend.
